盲目の国学者 塙保己一

塙保己一

江戸時代に活躍した盲目の国学者。7歳で失明した保己一は15歳の時、大志を抱いて江戸へ旅立ち、学者としての道を歩み始めました。34歳から全国に散らばっていた古い歴史資料や文学の収集・分類・整理を開始し、40年の歳月をかけ全666冊にも及ぶ国書「群書類従」を完成。「世のため、後のため」の志のもと、国学に尽力し大事業を成し遂げました。群書類従は歴史学・国学・国文学等の学術的な研究に多大な貢献をしています。

Hanawa Hokiichi

A blind scholar of the Japanese classics

A blind scholar of the Japanese classics in the Edo period. He lost his eyesight when he was seven. Having a great ambition, he went to Edo at the age of fifteen and began to start his career as a scholar. At the age of 34, he began to collect, categorize, and organize old historical materials and literary works that had been scattered throughout Japan, and over the course of 40 years, he compiled a total of 666 literature books "Gunsho Ruiju (Great collection of old documents)." With an ambition to "do his best for society and for the future," he devoted himself to the Japanese classics and completed the massive project. Gunsho Ruiju has contributed greatly to academic research in history, the Japanese classics, and national literature.

Hanawa Hokiichi's Kyu-taku (Former Residence)

Hokiichi lived in this house until he was fifteen. This two-story thatched-house of irimoya-zukuri (hip-and-gable roof structure) is designated as a national historical site.

Kyoshinsha Mohan Sanshitsu (A monumental facility where silkworms used to be raised)

Kyoshinsha Mohan Sanshitsu is a facility of silkworm-raising for learning that was built in 1894 by Kimura Kuzo, who devoted his entire life to the improvement of silk cultivation technology. Inside the facility, panels that introduce the sericulture industry are exhibited.

Hachiman-jinja (shrine)

It is said that Minamoto Yoshiie dropped by this shrine in 1051 on his way to Oshu-Kassen (Oshu Battle) and prayed for a victory by setting up an altar, and after winning the victory he revisited here and had Iwashimizu-Hachimangu relocated. The existing shrine pavilion was rebuilt during the Kyoho period of the Edo era.

雉岡城跡
